#### Year 11 GCSE Mocks and Summer Examinations

Year 11 pupils will complete their second set of Mock examinations from Monday 10 February to Friday 14 March. The timetable has already been shared with pupils and parents. I am pleased to see pupils responding well by attending and engaging in the new booster timetable. These exams will take place in lesson time in the United Reformed Church and other rooms in school. In between exams, pupils will have lessons and be supported to revise.

It is extremely important that if your child is in school, they attend the relevant school boosters for their subjects. These happen on a weekly basis. If your child has additional tuition, this should not be arranged when your children is expected to attend the school boosters.

During the Easter holidays we will also be hosting our Easter Academy from Monday 7 April to Thursday 17 April as the pupils move closer towards their examinations. Pupils do not have to be in uniform during these days. They must sign in and out as they enter and leave the building. I hope Year 11 make good use of these opportunities to enhance their revision.
